

10 Photographs Not Taken That Will Leave You Breathless

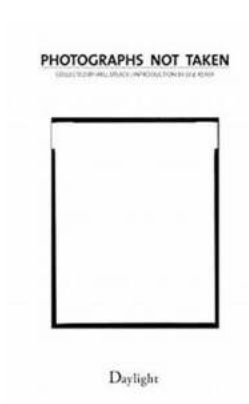

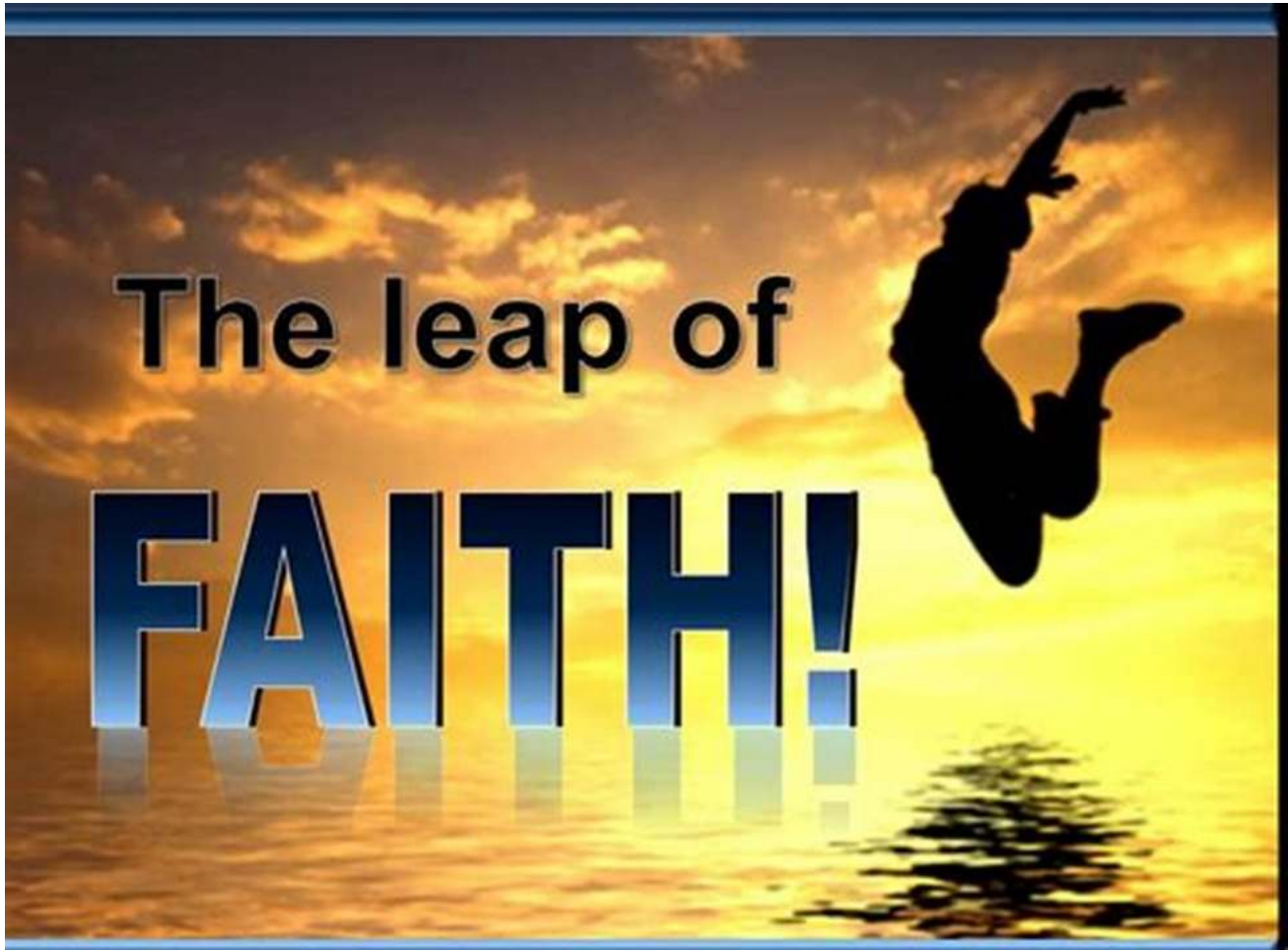


2. The Connection

7. The Transient Beauty



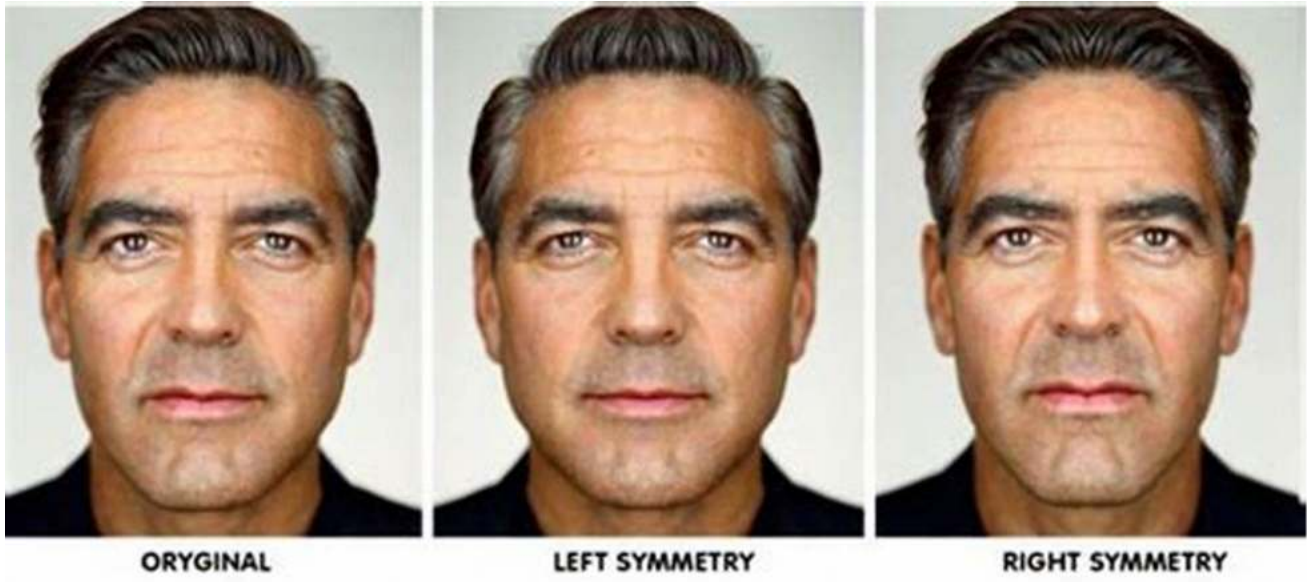
