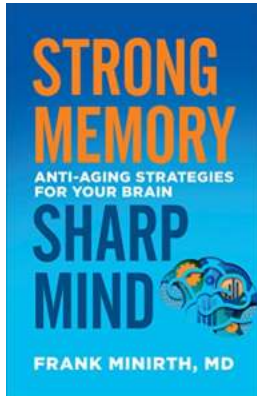
A Penguin Classic
