human rights or fair treatment of others, protection of the environment, and the alleviation of suffering. This is our agenda for the future.”



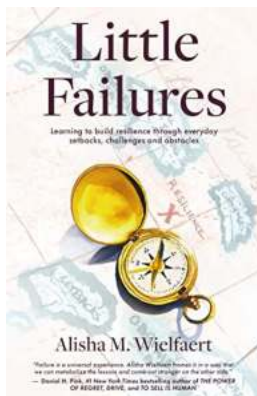
