This special 125th anniversary edition describes the unique challenges and triumphs that have marked the APA’s early years in the twenty-first century.



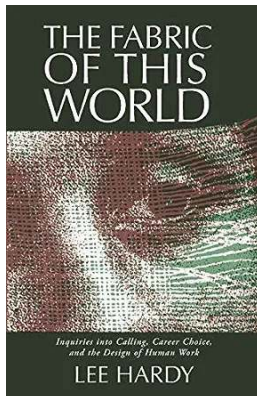
