



Shrewd Samaritan will help develop a framework to better love and care for our neighbors in an age of globalization, when the people in our neighborhoods, or at


least those in our potential sphere of influence, has expanded dramatically.

Increasingly it will become our global neighbor who takes us out of our comfort zone and challenges us with the needs of a broken world.




