Directed by James Burrows is a heart-and-soul master class in sitcom, revealing what it truly takes to get a laugh.



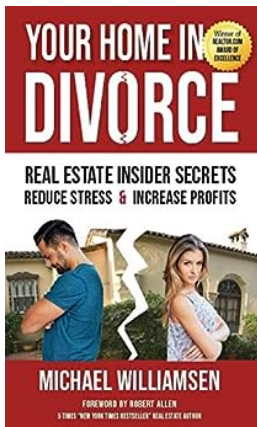
