Poli Poli tells the story of an extraordinary South African and the lesser-known social history of people, families, communities and places.



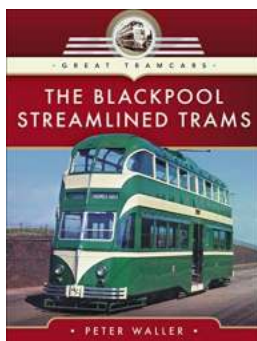
