

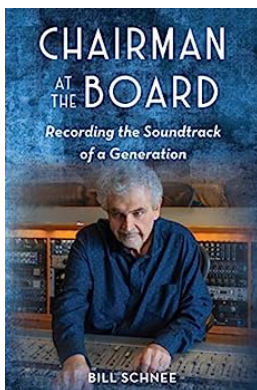

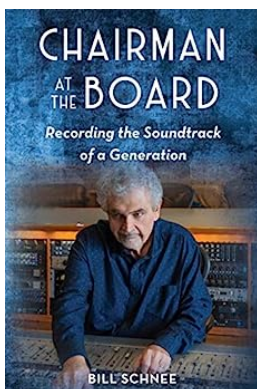

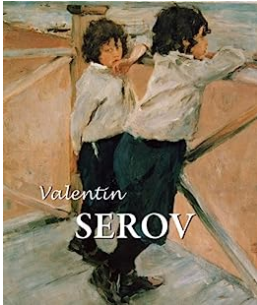

Clive Davis soon hired him to work for CBS where he partnered with famed music producer Richard Perry. Schnee went on to record and/or mix many of Perry's biggest albums of the '70s and '80s, including those by Barbra Streisand, Carly Simon, Ringo Starr, Art Garfunkel, and the Pointer Sisters.

With his deft personal touch with musicians, he continued to engineer and/or produce the likes of Marvin Gaye, Thelma Houston (the Grammy-nominated, direct-to-disc album *I've Got the Music in Me*), Pablo Cruise, Neil Diamond, Boz Scaggs, the Jacksons, Huey Lewis and the News, Dire Straits, and Whitney Houston.

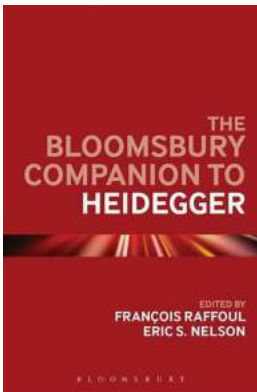
With over 125 gold and platinum records, and two Grammys for Steely Dan's *Aja* and *Gaucho*, Schnee has been called a living legend—recognized and respected

in the industry as the consummate music man with an incomparable career that he lovingly shares with his readers in humorous detail.



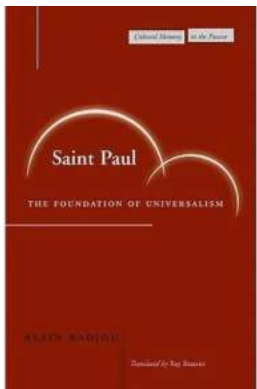
