I am thrilled to contribute to this important debate and especially that my book will be so quickly available to readers so they can make up their own minds.”



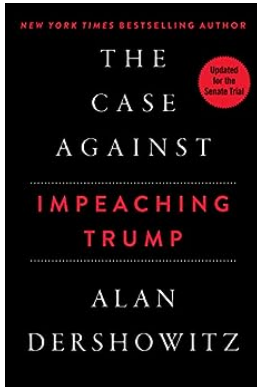
