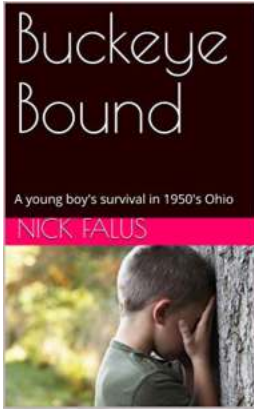

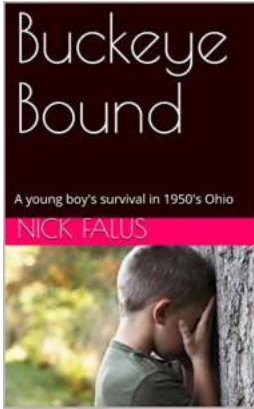

was able to recapture the joy of life.

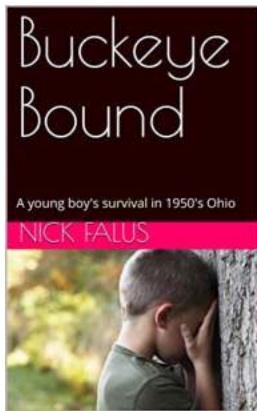
