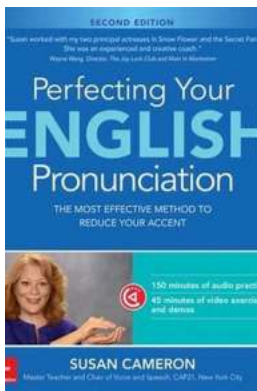
Anne Rice was raised in New Orleans as the devout child in a deeply religious
