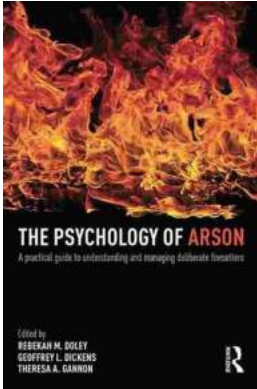
Thrill Arson 2
