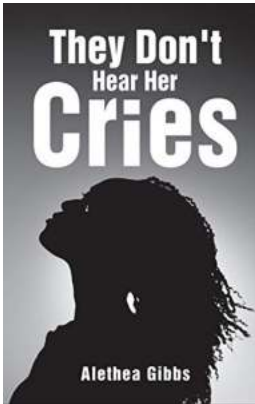

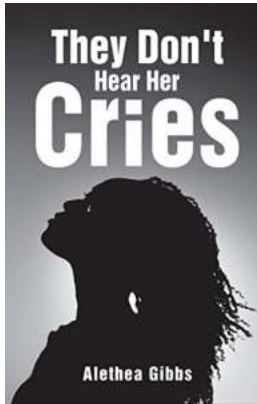
The Road Ahead

Remember – silence is no longer an option. The time for action is now.



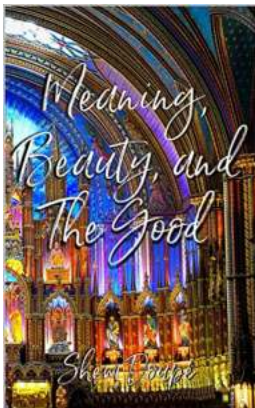

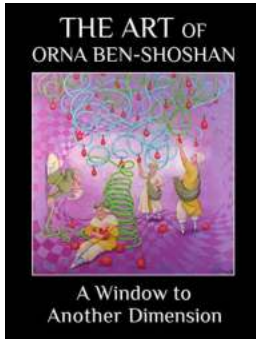

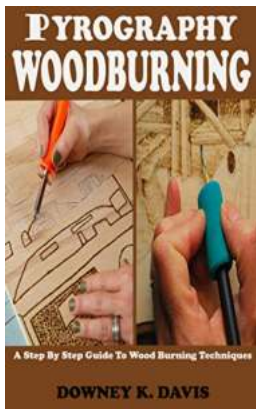
