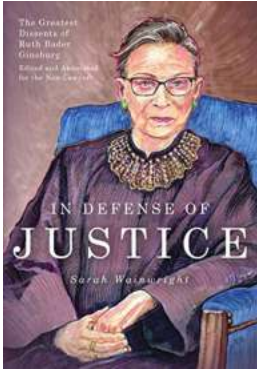

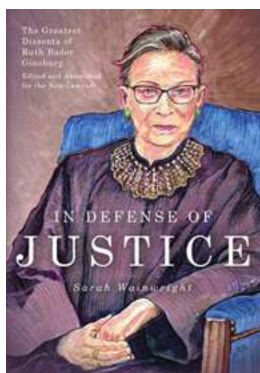

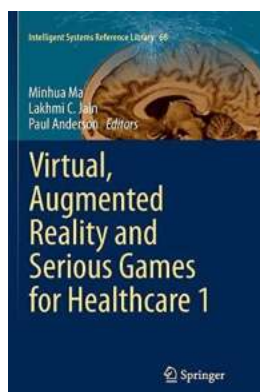

That year saw the release of two films about her—*On the Basis of Sex*, a biopic chronicling her years as a women's rights lawyer; and *RBG*, a documentary about her life.

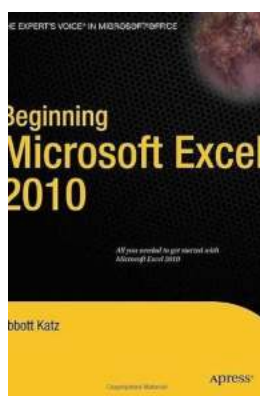
